## ASPIRING MIDDLE LEADER PROGRAMME

The Aspiring Middle Leader Programme (AMLP) will develop your skills as a middle leader and prepare you to lead a team effectively. You will analyse how effective leadership can improve outcomes for students in classes and raise the quality of teaching.

Our programmes are facilitated by experienced school leaders, with exemplary track records in leadership, and improving outcomes for their students.



## OBJECTIVES

Middle leaders have an essential role in translating the school's vision into practice. Outstanding schools need high quality middle leaders who can develop teacher skills and build high performing teams.

It is essential to schools and education that we identify, support and develop middle leaders. These emerging leaders are at the heart of successful schools.

The core objective of the AMLP is:

- To develop a range of leadership skills, knowledge and mind-sets, which can be used immediately to impact on improving schools through influencing others and raising standards.

## ELIGIBILITY

This programme is open to primary and secondary teachers who are considering school leadership. The programme is also suitable for current middle leaders new to their role.

Applicants need to demonstrate:

- a strong commitment to improving Teaching and Learning
- the skills to inspire colleagues
- strong interpersonal skills and who are positive role models for staff and students
- Evidence of the ability to become outstanding leaders
- a commitment to pro-active professional development and the ability evaluate the effectiveness of their own and that of others
- a willingness to develop their skills to influence and empower colleagues to excel.

## IMPACT AND EVALUATION

As part of the programme you will research and lead a session on a chosen area of school improvement that demonstrates your leadership skills and qualities.

You will have the opportunity to share your findings, and celebrate your success, with governors and school leaders at the end of the academic year.
